### **PROPERTY**


The planned Classroom upgrade will hopefully be starting by the end of the term. As soon as we get any information we will share it with you.

We are currently in the middle of being assessed regarding our schools property needs for its 10 year property plan. This determines the priorities and associated funding for the school property over the next 5 and 10 years. Any decision on the boiler will ultimately be part of this and notification of the 10YPP will be in July this year. As Mr McHutchon has mentioned—ten (interim) electric heaters have been installed. These will be reassessed as the year progresses to ensure that the heating is meeting the needs of staff and students.
