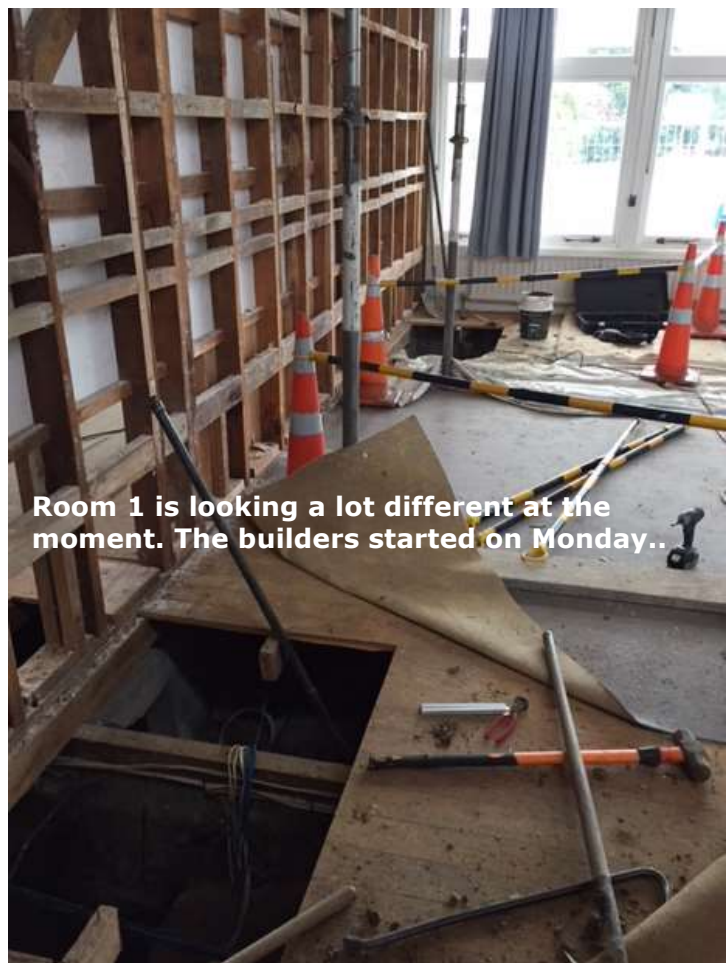
We welcome Kane and Mason Webster to Heriot School. These year two twins started with us this week and we wish them all the best for the upcoming term.
